This French-immersion summer program is more than just a French course, it's an opportunity for you to experience Francophone culture in a whole new way! The program allows participants to travel somewhere new and make new friends! It is open to all French levels; you are not required to be in French immersion to participate. The Official Languages programs (OLP) are funded by the government of Canada, and it's a great way to learn and practice French outside of the school year.

Candidates can select up to three preferences in their application, choosing which sessions interests them the most based on their location and what the host institution has to offer in order to make the program unique! The OLP is happy to offer Explore sessions in-person and virtually. The sooner you apply, the better your chances are of being selected for a spot.
